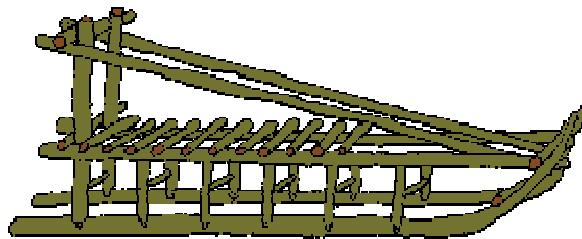


Mad River District Klondike 2006



General Information

- ❖ Only Patrols are allowed to participate in the Klondike Derby.
- ❖ Patrol leaders must register at Juneau Savings Bank (Located in the 49er's cabin) with a roster of their patrol when they arrive to get their starting time and pay your \$7.00 per person fee.
- ❖ All sleds will be judged for Craftsmanship, Style, and Creativity.
- ❖ Patrols must work as a team in order to successfully complete the Klondike. Outside help is not allowed. Patrols will pull their own sleds and complete the skill at each town using the information and knowledge they have from Scouting
- ❖ Scoutmasters will be asked to sign the patrol roster and decided which bracket the patrol will compete in senior bracket is for older scouts.
- ❖ Any patrol caught acting UNSCOUT like will be disqualified.
- ❖ Each patrol will be required to cook a hot lunch as part of the activity.
- ❖ Any complaints or problems through out the day should be brought to Juneau savings bank before the end of the event. (Located in the summer camp office)
- ❖ All visitors must register with the Juneau Savings Bank before going out on the trails.
- ❖ Any one not registered at the bank will be asked to leave.
- ❖ There will be no vehicles, except camp services vehicles, allowed beyond the parking lot for the entire weekend unless arrangements are made with the Camp Master and Activity Chairman ahead of time.
- ❖ First Aid is located in the Dining Hall not health lodge.
- ❖ Hot Cocoa and snacks will be available in the Dining Hall from 9:00am until 3:30 pm.
